

Core French 7 - Les articles possessifs

We use the “article possessif” in front of something that a person owns. Examples: my, our, your, etc... However, you have to choose the correct article based on whether the object that is being owned is masculine, feminine, singular or plural!

“**My**” = Ma (in front of a feminine word), Mon (in front of a masculine word), Mes (if the word is plural).

Ex: Mon menu (m.) = My menu
 Ma recette (f.) = My recipe
 Mes calculs (pl.) = My calculations

“**Your**” (informal or talking to one person) = Ta (fem.), Ton (mas.) or Tes (plural)

Ex: Ton menu (m.) = Your menu
 Ta recette (f.) = Your recipe
 Tes calculs (pl.) = Your calculations

“**His/her**” = Sa (fem.), Son (mas.) or Ses (plural)

Ex: Son menu (m.) = His/her menu
 Sa recette (f.) = His/her menu
 Ses calculs (pl.) His/her calculations

“**Our**” = Notre (*Feminin AND masculine*), or Nos (plural)

Ex: Notre menu (f./m.) = Our menu
 Nos calculs (pl.) = Our calculations

“**Your**” (formal or talking to more than one person) = Votre (*Feminine AND masculine*) or Vos (plural)

Ex: Votre recette (f./m.) = Your recipe
 Vos calculs (pl.) = Your calculations

“**Their**” = Leur (*Feminine AND Masculine*) or Leurs (plural)

Ex: Leur menu (f./m.) = Their menu
 Leurs calculs (pl.) = Their calculations
