Masculine and feminine adjectives

Usually, to make an adjective feminine, all you need to do is add "e".

For example: violent --- violente, grand ---- grande, petit ---- petite

However, <u>some</u> adjectives are special, and need a new ending. Check out the adjectives below:

<u>Masculine</u> <u>Feminine</u>

canad<u>ien</u> canad<u>ienne</u>

sensationn<u>elle</u> sensationn<u>elle</u>

merveill<u>eux</u> (= marvelous) merveill<u>euse</u>

sportif (= athletic) sportive

beau (nice) belle

bon bonne

If the masculine adjective ends in "e", no spelling change is needed for the feminine. For example:

triste (= sad) triste

bizarre bizarre

unique unique

Adjectifs --- pluriel

To make adjectives plural, just add "s". For example: vite----vites, petit----petits

However, if it ends in "x", there is no spelling change.

Also, if it ends in "eau", you make this plural by adding "x". For example: Nouveau----nouveaux
