



**Task:** In this portfolio task, students created an iMovie trailer for their short novels. Individually, students had to write a summary of their novel before working together in reading rotation groups to plan for their trailers by creating a storyboard, and film each other acting out their roles using costumes and props.

Criteria			
<b>Summary</b>	Writes a summary that includes some of the main ideas and important information from their novel.	Writes a summary that includes most of the main ideas and important information from their novel.	Writes a summary of their novel that is interesting and comprehensive.
<b>Storyboard</b>	Chooses a workable format for their trailer.  Plans for their trailer by completing their storyboard, providing some detail (characters, props, script, etc).	Chooses an appropriate format for their trailer.  Plans for their trailer by completing their storyboard, providing most details (characters, props, script, location, etc).	Chooses an effective layout for their trailer.  Plans for their trailer by thoroughly completing their storyboard, providing all necessary details (characters, props, script, location, timing, etc).
<b>Filming</b>	Is mostly prepared for filming, with some of the required materials.  Stays on task and respects timelines, some of the time.  Is somewhat mindful of technical elements (sound/volume, lighting).	Is prepared for filming, with most of required materials.  Stays on task and respects timelines, most of the time.  Is mindful of technical elements (sound/volume, lighting).	Comes prepared for filming, with all required materials.  Stays on task and respects timelines.  Monitors technical elements consistently (sound/volume, lighting, scheduling).
<b>Spelling and Grammar</b>	Little evidence of editing for spelling, punctuation and grammar in trailer.	Attempts to edit trailer for errors in punctuation, grammar and spelling.	Edits trailer for errors in punctuation, grammar and spelling.
<b>iTrailer</b>	Somewhat captures the audience's attention and is somewhat representative of the novel.	Is visually appealing and captures the audience's attention. Largely representative of the novel's storyline.	Captures the viewer's attention and persuades them to want to see "the movie" by properly representing the main intrigue of the novel.
